Proposed items for City Council candidates survey (*strongly agree, agree, no opinion, disagree, strongly disagree*):

- 1. I believe that increased use of "active" modes of transportation (i.e., walking and cycling) improves public health and reduces air pollution.
- 2. I support greater effort by the city to make Newark a more walkable and bikeable community.
- 3. I support increasing "low-stress" bicycle connectivity among and within the main areas of Newark, the University of Delaware, and outlying neighborhoods.
